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Certificate in Financial Literacy (Cefs)

This course is equivalent to AS level. It allows students to gain an appreciation of their individual needs, wants and aspirations. Students studying this course should learn the value and purpose of money, different types of financial products, money management and impact of legislature and regulation on earnings along with understanding income tax and national insurance.

Students will follow a course of study covering the following units.

- Unit 1 - Financial Capability for the Immediate and Short Term
- Unit 2 – Financial Capability for the Medium and Long Term

Diploma in Financial Studies (DipFs)

This course builds on knowledge gained in the Cefs and is equivalent to an A Level. Here students learn how to create a personal financial plan and explore the financial services market, discussing the aims and objectives of the various stakeholders in the industry.

Students will follow a course of study covering the following units.

- Unit 3 – Sustainability of an individual's Finances
- Unit 4 – Sustainability of the Financial Services System
